**NOTICE OF  
CONDITIONED  
NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

The City of Rensselaer Planning Commission, as State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, has determined that the proposed New Castle Asphalt blacktop plant project will not have a significant adverse environmental impact provided that specific conditions are met. The action involves the proposed construction and operation of a blacktop plant on an approximately 12.4-acre site in the Port of Rensselaer. The plant will be a drum mix manufacturing plant that mixes aggregate, recycled asphalt pavement and liquid asphalt to product blacktop. The project site is zoned for industrial uses and is adjacent to electrical generation plants to the north and east, a scrap metal facility to the northwest, petroleum storage facilities to the south and the Hudson River to the west. The project is located on Riverside Avenue in the Port of Rensselaer, City of Rensselaer. In summary, conditions imposed in the Conditioned Negative Declaration include: noise control measures; stormwater management requirements; measures to control air emissions, odors and fugitive dust; limits on delivery schedule of raw materials to the project site; requirement of no disturbance of the project site within 30 feet of the Hudson River; hoods on lights on project buildings; and Rensselaer County Health Department approval of on-site septic system. Written comments on the Conditioned Negative Declaration may be submitted through August 15, 2011.
