The Bureau will operate a six-week recreational program starting on Tuesday July 5th continuing each weekday (10:00am -2:00pm) through Friday August 12th. This program is NOT designed to provide daycare services for unsupervised youth . This program does offer wholesome recreational activities for all interested children. Most of the activities will be within the Boys and Girls club building at 544 Broadway, Riverfront Park, and East Street Spray Park.

Lunch: Lunch **WILL NOT** be provided. Your child **MUST** bring their own lunch but please remember we are a **NUT FREE** program.

Fun & games at Riverfront Park: The staff may take the children to Riverfront to play games and enjoy the park.

Cool off at East Street Park

**** EVERY Tuesday & Thursday****

Every Tuesday & Thursday the children will spend the afternoon (**WEATHER PERMITTING**) at the East Street Spray park. They will have the opportunity to cool off and enjoy the sprinkler. **PLEASE NOTE THE CHILDREN WILL WALK OVER TO THE PARK AT 11:45 AND WILL WALK BACK TO THE CLUB FOR 2:00 PICK UP. THERE WILL BE NO STAFF AT THE CLUB TO SUPERVISE YOUR CHILD IF THEY ARRIVE AFTER 11:30PM.**

Should you need to contact your child while at the Boys and Girls club please call the Youth Bureau office phone at 518-462-5488 and ask for your child to return your call. Our office staff will be glad to forward your message to your child!

The program ends at 2:00, all children MUST be picked up by 2:00. In the event that your child is not picked up at the Boys & Girls Club by 2:15, a phone call will be placed to the parent or guardian's number(s) listed. If necessary a message will be left.

If unable to contact parent or guardian at this time, a phone call will be placed to emergency contacts. If necessary a message will be left.

If our staff has been unsuccessful in attempting to contact any parent or guardian or emergency contact by 2:30pm, the Rensselaer Police Department will be contacted. At that point the Rensselaer Police Department will transport your child to its headquarters where every attempt will be made to contact you by a police officer. Please note that the child will then be considered abandoned and in most cases the police department will have no other choice but to file a report with child Protective Services of the Rensselaer County Department of Social Services.

If late pick-up occurs on a regular basis your child may not be allowed to continue attending the program.
