PRESS RELEASE

On Tuesday, July 30, 2024, at approximately 9:37am, the Rensselaer Police Department received a call for two male subjects carrying weedwhackers, backpacks and one suitcase, entering yards and knocking on doors in the area of 3rd Avenue and High Street. Responding officers made contact with both subjects in the area of 146 3rd Avenue.

One of the subjects, Carlos Omar Garcia-Hernandez, 32 years old, was discovered to have an outstanding warrant for felony drug possession out of New Mexico. Further investigation revealed Garcia-Hernandez and the second subject, Jimmy Mauricio Chancusig Quilumba, 24 years old, were in possession of stolen property taken from at least 3 separate locations.

Mr. Quilumba had an identification card issued out of New York City and a passport in his possession. Garcia-Hernandez had tickets for an Amtrak train traveling from New York City to Portland, Oregon in his possession. Garcia-Hernandez was fingerprinted to verify his identity based on the New Mexico warrant.

Once the fingerprint response was returned, confirming Mr. Garcia-Hernandez's identity, Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) contacted Rensselaer Police. Two Deportation Officers from Enforcement and Removal Operations responded to RPD. Both men were found to be in the country illegally, Garcia-Hernandez from Mexico and Quilumba from Ecuador.

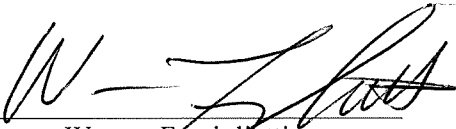
Carlos Omar Garcia-Hernandez was charged with the following;

- o Burglary 2nd – Class C Felony
- o Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th – Class E Felony
- o Grand Larceny 4th – Class E Felony
- o Conspiracy 4th – Class E Felony
- o Criminal Possession of a Weapon 4th (non-citizen) – Class A Misdemeanor
- o Petit Larceny – Class A Misdemeanor (2 counts)
- o Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5th – Class A Misdemeanor
- o Conspiracy 6th – Class B Misdemeanor
- o Criminal Trespass 3rd – Class B Misdemeanor

Jimmy Mauricio Chancusig Quilumba was charged with the following;

- Burglary 2nd – Class C Felony
- Grand Larceny 4th – Class E Felony
- Conspiracy 4th – Class E Felony
- Petit Larceny – Class A Misdemeanor
- Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 5th – Class A Misdemeanor
- Conspiracy 6th – Class B Misdemeanor

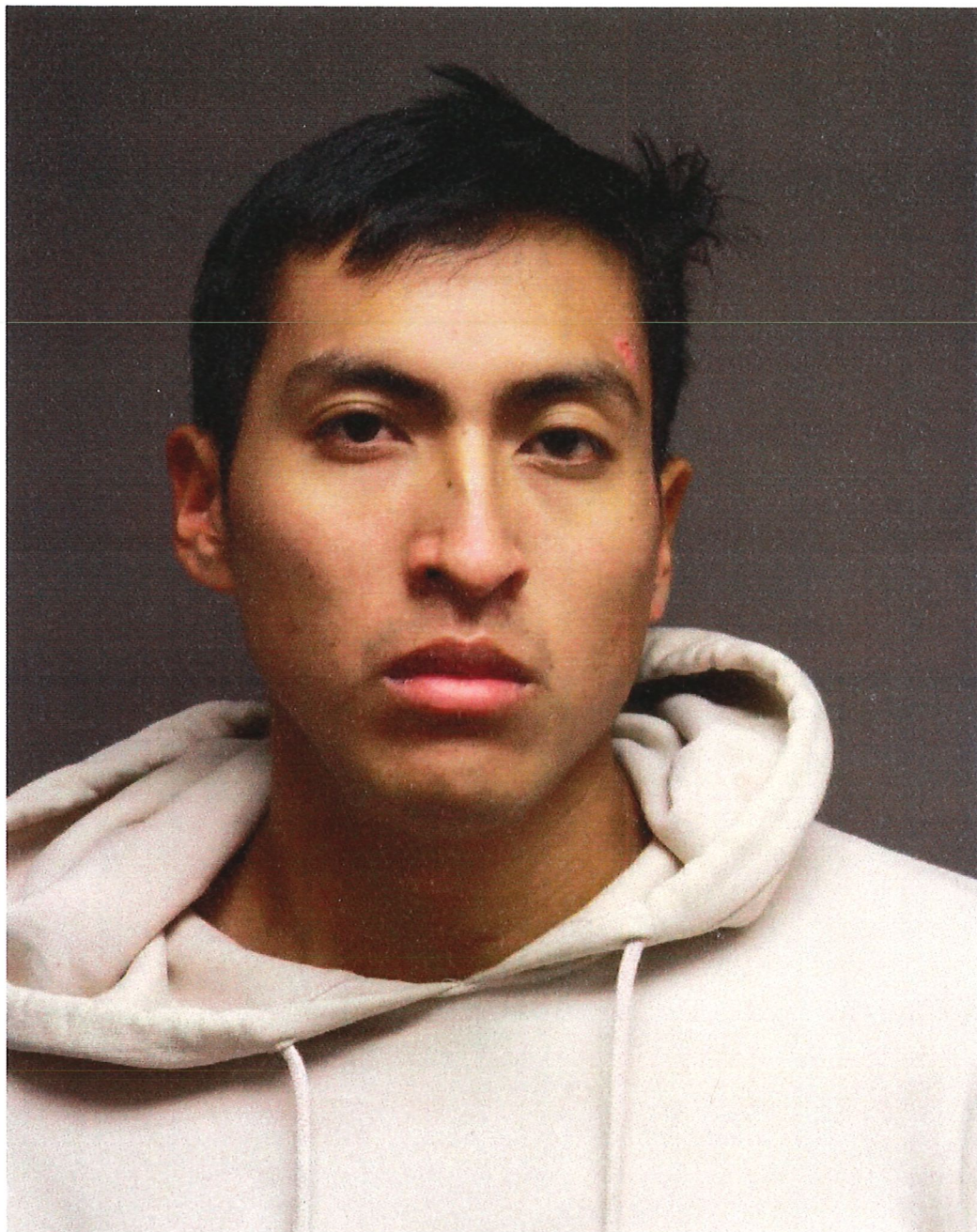
Both men were arraigned in Rensselaer City Court and remanded to the Rensselaer County Jail. Further court appearances are scheduled for Wednesday, August 7, 2024. Immigration Detainers were issued for both Garcia-Hernandez and Quilumba.
