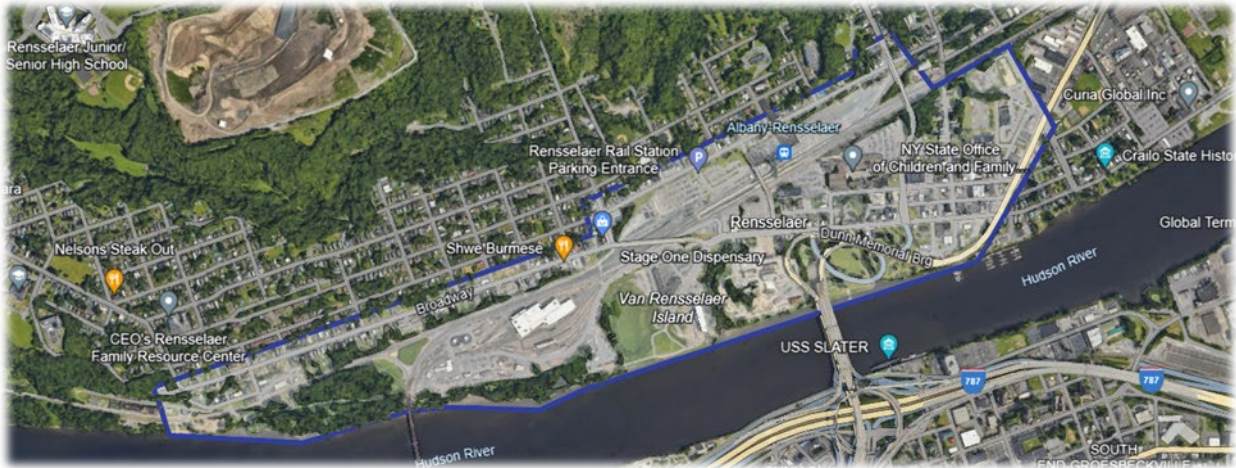


City of Rensselaer
