WHEREAS, the Common Council is desirous of conducting a Public Hearing to discuss the installation of "NO PARKING-FIRE LANE" sign on the West side of Walker Street between 1ST Ave and 2ND Ave, and replace a faded Stop and Street signs at is 1ST Ave (see attached), and

WHEREAS, the Common Council will carefully consider the aforementioned residents' quality of life and safety issues, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Public Hearing be scheduled for April 2, 2025 at 6:30 pm in the Courtroom at City Hall, 62 Washington St., Rensselaer to discuss the installation of said signs.
