**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REVIEW AND UPDATE OF THE ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT LOAN PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND RESCINDING THE ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT GRANT COMPONENT OF THE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer Economic Development Loan Committee met to review the status and operation of the City's Economic Development Loan Program; and

WHEREAS, the Committee reviewed the work previously completed by the Economic Development Loan Committee in 2022, including proposed revisions to the Economic Development Loan Program Fact Sheet, Guidelines, and Application Materials; and

WHEREAS, the Committee determined that further review and updating of the loan program documents is necessary to ensure that the program remains effective, transparent, and consistent with the City's economic development objectives; and

WHEREAS, the Committee further reviewed Resolution No. 2, adopted November 15, 2017, which amended the Economic Development Loan Program Guidelines to authorize grants not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of an approved loan amount, up to a maximum grant award of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000); and

WHEREAS, the Committee finds that the continued availability of grant awards reduces the resources available within the revolving loan fund and may adversely impact the long-term sustainability of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Committee recommends eliminating the grant component of the Economic Development Loan Program in order to preserve loan fund resources for future economic development projects within the City of Rensselaer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer hereby accepts the recommendation of the Economic Development Loan Committee and directs that the proposed revisions to the Economic Development Loan Program Fact Sheet, Guidelines, and Application Materials be reviewed and finalized for future consideration and adoption by the Common Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 2, adopted on November 15, 2017, authorizing grant awards of up to fifty percent (50%) of an approved loan amount, not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), is hereby rescinded in its entirety; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon adoption of this Resolution, the Economic Development Loan Program shall operate solely as a loan program, and no new grant awards
