DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY — ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY (120) DAY FINANCIAL EXTENSION ON LOANS

A State of Emergency having been declared in the City of Rensselaer, New York, effective 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, March 18th, 2020.

The State of Emergency was declared to respond effectively to the outbreak of COVID-19, a virus which threatens the public safety of the citizens of Rensselaer, New York. Such threat to public safety now being determined to continue to exist.

Therefore, in the spirit of the Governor's Executive Order No. 202.9, I hereby extend the time period for Obligors to the City of Rensselaer to pay any monthly installments on Economic Development Loans, Fort Crailo Revolving Loans, and Rensselaer City Rehabilitation Loans for a period of One Hundred and Twenty (120) Days from March 18th, 2020, as long as such Obligors were current on their loan payments as of March 18th, 2020, and I further wave on behalf of the City of Rensselaer any late fees, interest or penalties that otherwise would apply to such City Loans during the One Hundred and Twenty (120) Day Extension.

As Mayor of the City of Rensselaer, New York, I, Michael Stammel, have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law Article 2-B, and the Charter of the City of Rensselaer, to preserve the public safety and render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health, both physical and financial, of the citizens of this municipality.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the City of Rensselaer, New York, to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
